Author of New Book on Sex Trafficking in America Issues Statement on #bringbackourgirls

Former pastor Jamie Greening's new book, *The Little Girl Waits*, is a piece of fiction, but it is based on the troubling reality that sex trafficking is a problem right here in America, not just in Nigeria, where the world's attention is currently focused. He has issued the following statement:

"My prayers are for the almost 300 girls still missing in Nigeria, and I applaud all efforts to bring awareness to the problem and to save those girls. This kind of violence, abuse, and terror cannot be tolerated. The truth, however, is that it is a far bigger problem than evil warlords in Nigeria. Each year over 50,000 children go missing in the United States, and a large number of them are forced into some kind of sex-slavery. We should keep posting #bringbackourgirls, but we also must open our eyes to the same type of violence, abuse, and terror going on in every city in America."
